2026 Championship Season

Jr-Sr Championship has Opened: The 2026 Jr-Sr Championship registration is open. The 2026 Jr-Sr will be played at the Mission Inn in Howey-in-the-Hills, FL. (just outside Orlando). This year's event includes four (4) rounds of golf (a practice round and three tournament rounds) at the resort's two courses, on-site accommodation, lunches, and a player reception. Tournament dates are April 19-22. Sign up early as space is limited.

Senior Amateur: Final site to be determined. Tentative dates May 11- 14

Trans-Miss Amateur: Host site of the Elite Amateur Series event is set for July 6-10 at Southern Hills CC in Tulsa, OK.

Mid-Master/Mid-Am: The 2026 Championship will be played at Lakewood Country Club in Denver, CO, on September 13-16, 2026.

Special Commemorative events will take place during each championship on the 2026 schedule, celebrating 125 years as a leader in amateur golf and supporting the game through our Turf Scholarship Fund.

A look back:

2025 Mid-Master Championship. The third edition of the Trans-Miss Mid Master Championship was played at the Rancho Santa Fe Golf Club. Ben Briscoe started with two fantastic rounds and a seven-under total for a five-shot victory in the Mid Master Division over Hames Snediker (TN), with Trae Cassell (CA) another shot back. In the Mid-Am division, Ryan Burgess of Dallas, nine under total, was good enough for a five-shot win over Terry Ryan (TN) and Marian Ludwig from Germany. Rancho Santa Fe was a fantastic host venue that provided an actual championship experience for the players.

2025 Scholars Applications

The Turf Scholarship and Club Intern program is now reviewing nominations for scholarships. This year, the Trans-Miss Turf Scholarship Fund will again provide over \$150,000 in scholarships and grants to students pursuing careers in agronomy. This year, 25 students were nominated from 10 universities with agronomy programs, along with nine clubs requesting interns from the club intern program. Additional funds raised through the Ambassadors Club will help students cover the full cost of their education.
